



## SALUS, Samuel Weider

SALUS, Samuel W., a Representative from Philadelphia County; born, August 30, 1872 in the City of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, Pa.; graduated, Central High School, 1891; graduated, University of Pennsylvania Law School, 1895; attorney; elected, common council, City of Philadelphia (1902-1903); elected as a Republican to the Pennsylvania House of Representatives for the 1903, 1909, 1943, and 1945 terms; Assistant District Attorney, Philadelphia County (1904-1907); elected, Pennsylvania State Senate (1911-1938); president pro tempore, Pennsylvania Senate (1925-1938); died while in office, December 28, 1945.
