BURKARDT, Robert F., a Representative from Allegheny County; born in Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, Pa., October 17, 1923; graduated, Central Catholic High School; A.B., University of Pittsburgh, 1947; LL.B, J.D., University of Pittsburgh Law School, 1950; served, United States Infantry (1943); served, United States Air Force (1943-1945, World War II); lieutenant colonel, Judge Advocate General, United States Air Force Reserve; attorney; Special Assistant Attorney General, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (1964); chairman, Allegheny County Republican Primary Campaign (1966); coordinator, Allegheny County General Election (1966); legal staff , Republican Executive Committee; unsuccessful candidate, judge, Common Pleas Court; unsuccessful candidate, commissioner, Allegheny County (1967); elected as a Republican to the Pennsylvania House of Representatives in 1968, 1970, and 1972; unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the House in the 1974 General election; died, December 1, 2006; interred in Oakmont-Verona Cemetery, Oakmont, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.
