The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds. Section 6. - (b) Levy.--Beginning after December 31, 2014, a county may, in its discretion, by ordinance, impose [a] an annual fee of \$5 for each nonexempt vehicle registered to an address located in the county. A county shall notify the department of the passage of the ordinance 90 days prior to the effective date of the ordinance.
- (c) Collection.—The department shall collect fees imposed under subsection [(a)] (b) at the time a vehicle is registered and shall deposit the money in the Fee for Local Use Fund.
