Learners' permits. 1 \* \* \* 2 3 (b) Learner must be accompanied. -- A learner's permit 4 entitles the person to whom it was issued to drive vehicles and 5 combinations of vehicles of the class or classes specified, but only while the holder of the learner's permit is accompanied by 6 7 and under the immediate supervision of a person who: 8 (1) is at least 21 years of age or, if the spouse of the 9 learner's permit holder, is at least 18 years of age; or, if a parent, guardian or person in loco parentis of the 10 11 learner's permit holder, is at least 18 years of age; is licensed to drive vehicles of the class then 12 (2)13 being driven by the holder of the learner's permit; [and] 14 (3) is actually occupying a seat beside the holder of 15 the learner's permit unless the vehicle is a motorcycle[.]; 16 and 17 (4) is not manifestly under the influence of alcohol or 18 a controlled substance, except a controlled substance taken pursuant to a lawful order of a practitioner, to the degree 19 20 that the person may endanger themselves or others. \* \* \* 21 22 § 1543.
