5 § 5705. [(Reserved).] Food allergy awareness.

6 (a) Requirements.--Each proprietor of a retail food facility
7 shall comply with all of the following:

8 (1) Prominently display a poster acceptable to the
9 department and in accordance with subsection (b) in the
10 employee area that provides information for employees on food
11 allergy awareness.

12 (2) Include on a food menu or through other written
13 information a notice to a customer of food allergens used in
14 the retail food facility and a request for the customer to
15 inform the employee serving the customer about the customer's
16 food allergy.

17 (b) Posters.--The department shall require posters under
18 this section to contain, at a minimum, a description of the
19 major food allergens and symptoms of an allergic reaction and
20 any other requirements that are specified in the Food Code,
21 published by the United States Food and Drug Administration. The
22 following apply:

23 (1) The secretary shall transmit notice of the other
24 requirements that are specified in the version of the Food
25 Code that is in effect on the effective date of this
26 paragraph to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication
27 in the next available issue of the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

28 (2) The secretary shall review any subsequent changes to
29 the other requirements that are specified under the Food Code
30 and shall transmit notice of the changes to the Legislative
31 Reference Bureau for publication in the next available issue
32 of the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
