(b) Posters. -- The department shall require posters under 17 this section to contain, at a minimum, a description of the 18 major food allergens and symptoms of an allergic reaction and 19 any other requirements that are specified in the Food Code, 20 published by the United States Food and Drug Administration. The 21 22 following apply: 23 (1) The secretary shall transmit notice of the other requirements that are specified in the version of the Food 24 25 Code that is in effect on the effective date of this paragraph to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication_ 26 27 in the next available issue of the Pennsylvania Bulletin. (2) The secretary shall review any subsequent changes to 28 29 the other requirements that are specified under the Food Code 30 and shall transmit notice of the changes to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the next available issue 31 of the Pennsylvania Bulletin. 32
