A RESOLUTION

- Urging the Congress of the United States to support the Major 2
- Richard Star Act (H.R. 1282) to allow all medically retired
- service members to receive full access to their much-deserved
- retirement pay and benefits. 4
- 5 WHEREAS, Major Richard Star was an Iraq and Afghanistan
- veteran who, after exposure to burn pits during his service,
- 7 received a diagnosis of lung cancer; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Due to his diagnosis, Major Richard Star was forced
- to retire before completing 20 years of service and was
- therefore unable to collect his retirement and disability 10
- benefits; and 11
- 12 WHEREAS, For every dollar of disability pay they receive,
- 13 veterans with less than 20 years of service and a disability
- 14 rating of less than 50% will have their retirement pay reduced
- 15 by a dollar; and
- 16 WHEREAS, An estimated 50,000 retired service members are
- ineligible for concurrent benefits under the current rules; and 17

- 1 WHEREAS, According to the Congressional Budget Office, in
- 2 2022, the average offset was approximately \$1,900 a month; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Major Richard Star Act would remove these
- 4 restrictions and ensure that all service members who have
- 5 medically retired can receive full access to retirement pay and
- 6 Department of Veterans Affairs disability benefits; and
- 7 WHEREAS, After dying from his battle with lung cancer in
- 8 2021, Major Richard Star's widow claimed that his greatest goal
- 9 was to get legislation passed providing for the removal of these
- 10 restrictions; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The United States owes these benefits to its
- 12 veterans regardless of the cost associated with their
- 13 allocation; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
- 16 States to support the Major Richard Star Act (H.R. 1282) to
- 17 allow all medically retired service members to receive full
- 18 access to their much-deserved retirement pay and benefits; and
- 19 be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 21 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania call upon our colleagues in the
- 22 Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to urge the Congress
- 23 of the United States to support the Major Richard Star Act (H.R.
- 24 1282); and be it further
- 25 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 26 each member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
