## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in State Board of Education, further
- 6 providing for membership and for powers and duties of board.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Sections 2602-B and 2603-B(a) and (b) of the act
- 10 of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School
- 11 Code of 1949, added March 30, 1988 (P.L.321, No.43), are amended
- 12 to read:
- 13 Section 2602-B. Membership.--(a) (1) The board shall
- 14 consist of twenty-one (21) members, ten (10) of whom shall also
- 15 serve as members of the Council of Basic Education, and ten (10)
- 16 of whom shall also serve as members of the Council of Higher
- 17 Education. The member [designated by the Governor] <u>elected</u> as
- 18 chairman of the board shall also service as a member of the
- 19 Council of Basic Education and of the Council of Higher
- 20 Education.

- 1 (2) Except the legislative members and legislative
- 2 appointments, each member shall be appointed by the Governor[,]
- 3 by and with the advice and consent of a majority of all the
- 4 members of the Senate[, and shall, except].
- 5 (3) Except as hereinafter provided, each member shall hold
- 6 office for terms of six (6) years each or until his successor
- 7 has been appointed and has qualified. An appointment to fill a
- 8 vacancy shall be for the unexpired term or until his successor
- 9 has been appointed and has qualified.
- 10 (4) The President pro tempore of the Senate shall appoint
- 11 three (3) members with full voting privileges to the board as
- 12 <u>follows:</u>
- (i) one (1) appointee shall be a member of the Senate who
- 14 shall serve as an ex officio member of the board;
- 15 (ii) one (1) appointee shall be a current or former member
- 16 of a board of school directors in this Commonwealth; and
- 17 (iii) one (1) appointee shall be a current or former public
- 18 school teacher or administrator in this Commonwealth.
- 19 (5) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
- 20 appoint three (3) members with full voting privileges to the
- 21 board as follows:
- 22 <u>(i) one (1) appointee shall be a member of the House of</u>
- 23 Representatives who shall serve as an ex officio member of the
- 24 board;
- 25 (ii) one (1) appointee shall be a current or former member
- 26 of a board of school directors in this Commonwealth; and
- 27 <u>(iii) one (1) appointee shall be a current or former public</u>
- 28 school teacher or administrator in this Commonwealth.
- 29 (6) The chairmen and minority chairmen of the House of
- 30 Representatives and Senate Education Committees, or their

- 1 respective designees from such committees, shall serve as ex
- 2 officio members of the board with full voting privileges and
- 3 shall serve as members for as long as they hold their respective
- 4 positions.
- 5 (7) The Chairman of the Professional Standards and Practices
- 6 Commission, or a commission member designated by the chairman,
- 7 created by the act of December 12, 1973 (P.L.397, No.141),
- 8 referred to as the Teacher Certification Law, shall be an ex
- 9 officio member of the board without voting privileges or
- 10 assignment to either council.
- 11 (8) Members shall receive no salary but shall be entitled to
- 12 travel expenses and other necessary expenses incurred in the
- 13 performance of their duties as members of the board.
- 14 (b) Eleven (11) members shall constitute a quorum provided
- 15 that at least five (5) members serving on each of the councils
- 16 are present. The affirmative vote of a majority of all the
- 17 members of the board duly recorded showing how each member voted
- 18 shall be required in order to take action adopting statements of
- 19 policy, standards, rules and regulations. The board shall meet
- 20 at least six (6) times a year at such times and places as it
- 21 shall determine. Special meetings may be called by the chairman
- 22 or at the request of a majority of the members of the board.
- (c) An appointed member who fails to attend three (3)
- 24 consecutive board meetings shall forfeit his or her membership
- 25 on the board, unless the board chairman, upon written request
- 26 from the member, determines that the member should be excused
- 27 from a meeting or meetings for reasons of illness or the death
- 28 of an immediate family member.
- 29 (d) (1) The [Governor shall designate, to serve at his
- 30 pleasure, a member as] members of the board shall, with the

- 1 <u>recommendation of the Governor, elect by majority vote a member</u>
- 2 of the board to act as chairman of the board.
- 3 (2) The chairman of the board, or a member of the board
- 4 designated by the chairman, shall be an ex officio member of the
- 5 Professional Standards and Practices Commission, without voting
- 6 privileges.
- 7 (e) (1) For the purpose of formulating policy proposals
- 8 applicable to elementary, secondary, vocational-technical
- 9 education and higher education in this Commonwealth, there shall
- 10 be two councils, which shall consist of ten (10) members of the
- 11 board each, the chairman being a member of both councils, and
- 12 shall be known as the Council of Basic Education and the Council
- 13 of Higher Education. [The Governor shall designate to serve at
- 14 his pleasure a member serving on each council to act as chairman
- 15 of the council.]
- 16 (2) The members of each council shall, with the
- 17 <u>recommendation of the Governor, elect by majority vote a member</u>
- 18 of the council to act as chairman of the council. Each council
- 19 shall meet at the call of its chairman or at the request of a
- 20 majority of the members of the council.
- 21 (3) The chairman of the board may appoint special joint
- 22 committees from among the members of the board to formulate
- 23 policy proposals in those areas which fall within the purview of
- 24 both of the councils.
- 25 (f) Except for the chairman, not more than two (2) members
- 26 serving on each council shall be employed [either in a school
- 27 system or] in the Department of Education. [For purposes of this
- 28 subsection, the State System of Higher Education shall not be
- 29 considered a school system.] Three (3) members of the Council of
- 30 Higher Education shall be actively employed by an institution of

- 1 higher education, at least one holding an administrative
- 2 position and at least one holding a professional position on a
- 3 faculty of an institution of higher education. At least two (2)
- 4 members serving on each council shall have had previous
- 5 experience with vocational-technical education or training.
- 6 (g) The Secretary of Education, or his designated
- 7 representative, shall be the chief executive officer of the
- 8 board, shall be entitled to attend all meetings of the board and
- 9 councils, and shall have the right to speak on all matters
- 10 before the board and the councils but not to vote.
- 11 Section 2603-B. Powers and Duties of the Board. -- (a) (1)
- 12 The board shall have the power, and its duty shall be, to review
- 13 the statements of policy, standards, rules and regulations
- 14 formulated by the Council of Basic Education and the Council of
- 15 Higher Education, and adopt broad policies and principles, and
- 16 establish standards governing the educational program of the
- 17 Commonwealth.
- 18 (2) When adopting and establishing policies, principles,
- 19 standards, rules and regulations, the board shall consider the
- 20 economic impact and cost of implementing the policies,
- 21 principles, standards, rules and regulations.
- 22 (b) (1) The board and the Secretary of Education shall
- 23 jointly employ and fix the compensation of such staff as it
- 24 deems necessary to perform the duties of the board: Provided,
- 25 <u>however</u>, That the chairman of the board shall have sole
- 26 discretion to select an executive director for the board who
- 27 <u>shall serve at the pleasure of the chairman</u>.
- 28 (2) The board shall be entitled to legal counsel which shall
- 29 be designated by the Office of General Counsel, which legal
- 30 counsel shall not also be legal counsel to the Department of

- 1 Education.

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
