AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in trade and commerce, prohibiting the
3 retail sale and distribution of novelty lighters; and
4 imposing a penalty.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 7332. Retail sale and distribution of novelty lighters
10 prohibited.

11 (a) Offense defined.--It shall be unlawful for any person to
12 sell at retail, offer for retail sale or distribute for retail
13 sale or promotion in this Commonwealth a novelty lighter.

14 (b) Grading.--A person who violates subsection (a) commits a
15 summary offense.

16 (c) Exception.--Nothing contained in this section may
17 prohibit the transportation of novelty lighters through this
18 Commonwealth or the storage of novelty lighters in a warehouse
19 or distribution center in this Commonwealth if the warehouse or

1 distribution center is closed to the public for purposes of
2 retail sales.

3 (d) Definition.--As used in this section the term "novelty
4 lighter" means a mechanical or electrical device typically used
5 for lighting cigarettes, cigars or pipes that is designed to
6 appear to be a toy, to feature a flashing light or to make
7 musical sounds. The term does not include:

8 (1) A lighter manufactured prior to January 1, 1980.

9 (2) A lighter incapable of being fueled or lacking a
10 device necessary to produce combustion or a flame.

11 (3) Any mechanical or electrical device primarily used
12 to ignite fuel for fireplaces or for charcoal or gas grills.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
