AN ACT

Amending Title 40 (Insurance) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, providing for life insurance 2 3 database. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 40 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 7 § 102. Life insurance database. 8 9 (a) Contact information. -- The following shall apply regarding contact information: 10 (1) The department or its designee shall maintain an 11 12 electronic database of contact information for each life 13 insurer that has life insurance policies or annuity contracts 14 in force in this Commonwealth. 15 (2) All life insurers, including those insurers under Article XXIV of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), 16

known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, having a life

1	insurance policy or annuity contract in force in this
2	Commonwealth shall provide and maintain with the department
3	or its designee a valid e-mail address to which the
4	department or its designee may send the requests received
5	under this act.
6	(b) Who may request search
7	(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the following may file
8	with the department or its designee a request to conduct a
9	search for life insurance policies or annuity contracts
10	<pre>covering a decedent:</pre>
11	(i) A member of the decedent's family who has
12	requested and obtained a copy of the decedent's death
13	<pre>certificate.</pre>
14	(ii) An executor or administrator of the decedent's
15	<u>estate.</u>
16	(2) A request to conduct a search may occur only if:
17	(i) the decedent was a resident or former resident
18	of this Commonwealth; and
19	(ii) the request is accompanied by a copy of the
20	decedent's death certificate.
21	(3) The right to file a request to conduct a search may
22	not be assigned.
23	(c) Submittal of search request
24	(1) The department or its designee shall transmit a
25	request to conduct a search to all life insurers having life
26	insurance policies or annuity contracts in force in this
27	Commonwealth along with information necessary for responding
28	directly to the person filing the request.
29	(2) The information submitted to insurers must be on a
30	standardized form or the search requests must be available to

- 1 the life insurers on the secure website of the department or
- 2 <u>its designee.</u>
- 3 (d) Good faith efforts.--
- 4 (1) In response to a search request under this section,
- 5 <u>each insurer shall in good faith examine its books and</u>
- 6 records to determine whether the decedent is covered by a
- 7 <u>life insurance policy or annuity contract. Upon a finding</u>
- 8 that coverage does exist, the insurer shall directly notify
- 9 <u>the person filing the request BENEFICIARY OR BENEFICIARIES TO <--</u>
- 10 WHOM THE BENEFITS ARE DUE.
- 11 (2) Within 90 days of receiving the search request from
- 12 <u>the department or its designee, the insurer shall complete</u>
- good faith efforts to confirm the death of the insured,
- 14 annuity contract holder or retained assets account holder
- against other available records and information. The efforts
- shall be documented by the insurer and determine whether
- benefits are due in accordance with the applicable policy or
- 18 contract.
- 19 (e) Beneficiary claim. -- If, as a result of the search under
- 20 this section, benefits are due, the insurer shall:
- 21 (1) Use good faith efforts to locate each beneficiary.
- The efforts shall be documented by the insurer.
- 23 (2) Provide the appropriate claims forms or instructions
- to each beneficiary to make a claim, including instructions
- 25 on the need to provide an official death certificate, if
- 26 applicable under the policy or contract.
- 27 <u>(f) General procedure.--An insurer under this section shall</u>
- 28 implement procedures to account for all of the following:
- 29 (1) Common nicknames, initials used in lieu of a first
- or middle name, use of a middle name, compound first and

1	middle names and interchanged first and middle names.
2	(2) Compound last names, maiden or married names and
3	hyphens, blank spaces or apostrophes in last names.
4	(3) Transposition of the month and date portions of the
5	date of birth.
6	(4) An incomplete Social Security number.
7	(g) Fees
8	(1) The department may charge a fee of \$10 for each
9	search request processed through the database.
10	(2) The department may develop and implement an
11	electronic payment system that may be used regarding search
12	requests.
13	(3) Beginning one year after the effective date of this
14	section, the department shall have authority to increase the
15	fee charged. The fee increase may not exceed:
16	(i) an annual cost-of-living adjustment as
17	calculated by applying the percentage increase in the
18	Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for
