- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, providing for digitized 1 2 driver's licenses. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. - 2 § 1591. Scope of subchapter.
- 3 This subchapter relates to digitized driver's licenses, which
- 4 may be used in addition to the driver's licenses required under
- 5 this chapter.
- 6 <u>§ 1592</u>. Purpose.
- 7 The purpose of this subchapter is to provide an individual
- 8 with a driver's license issued by the Commonwealth the option of
- 9 <u>downloading a digitized version of the driver's license of the</u>
- 10 individual through a mobile app that the department would offer.
- 11 § 1593. Definitions.
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 13 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 14 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 15 "Digitized driver's license." A data file available on a
- 16 mobile device that has connectivity to the Internet through an
- 17 application that:
- 18 (1) allows the mobile device to download the data file
- from the department or an authorized representative of the
- 20 <u>department;</u>
- 21 (2) contains all the data elements visible on the face
- 22 and back of the driver's license of an individual; and
- 23 (3) displays the current status of the driver's license
- of an individual, including, but not limited to, valid,
- 25 <u>expired, canceled, suspended, revoked, disqualified, hardship</u>
- 26 <u>or interlock hardship status.</u>
- 27 § 1594. Mobile app.
- The department shall offer to each individual with a driver's
- 29 license issued by the Commonwealth a mobile app capable of
- 30 downloading a digitized driver's license for the individual.

- 1 § 1595. Validity of digitized driver's license.
- 2 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in
- 3 subsection (b), a digitized driver's license shall serve the
- 4 <u>same purpose and have the same effect as any other driver's</u>
- 5 <u>license under this chapter.</u>
- 6 (b) Exception. -- A digitized driver's license shall not
- 7 <u>negate the obligation to have and carry a physical version of a</u>
- 8 <u>driver's license as specified under the other provisions of this</u>
- 9 <u>chapter. A digitized driver's license shall supplement and not</u>
- 10 replace a physical version of a driver's license required under
- 11 the other provisions of this chapter.
- 12 § 1596. Effect of other electronic images.
- A digital copy, photograph or any other image of a driver's
- 14 <u>license that is not downloaded as a digitized driver's license</u>
- 15 <u>shall not be valid for purposes of this chapter.</u>
- 16 § 1597. Effect on law enforcement.
- 17 (a) Citation.--If an individual is unable to produce a
- 18 physical version of the driver's license of the individual in
- 19 connection with a traffic stop or checkpoint, the individual may
- 20 present the individual's digitized driver's license to a law
- 21 enforcement officer. In such an instance, the law enforcement
- 22 officer may not issue a citation to the individual for driving a
- 23 motor vehicle without having the physical version of the
- 24 driver's license.
- 25 (b) Unlawful search. -- The following shall apply in the
- 26 absence of a valid search warrant regarding an individual's
- 27 mobile device:
- 28 (1) The display of an individual's digitized driver's
- 29 <u>license shall not be construed as consent or authorization by</u>
- 30 the individual for a law enforcement officer or any other

- 1 person to search, view or access any other data or
- 2 <u>application on the individual's mobile device.</u>
- 3 (2) If an individual presents a mobile device to a law
- 4 <u>enforcement officer or other person for the purpose of</u>
- 5 <u>displaying the individual's digitized driver's license, the</u>
- 6 <u>law enforcement officer or other person shall promptly return</u>
- 7 the mobile device to the individual immediately after the law
- 8 enforcement officer or other person has had the opportunity
- 9 to verify the identity or driver's license status of the
- 10 individual.
- 11 § 1598. Fees.
- 12 The department shall prescribe a schedule of reasonable fees
- 13 for an individual to use the mobile app established under this
- 14 <u>subchapter. The fees shall be designed to keep the mobile app</u>
- 15 <u>accessible and functioning and may include:</u>
- 16 (1) A reasonable download fee.
- 17 (2) A reasonable fee when the driver's license of the
- individual is renewed or when the information on the driver's
- 19 license of the individual is updated.
- 20 § 1599. Rules and regulations.
- 21 The department shall promulgate rules and regulations
- 22 necessary to implement the provisions of this subchapter.
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
