Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles, further providing for registration of snowmobile or ATV and for fees 2 3 and providing for nonresident ATV pass. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Sections 7711.1(f) and 7715.2(a) of Title 75 of 8 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 9 § 7711.1. Registration of snowmobile or ATV. * * * 10 11 (f) Exemptions from registration. -- Subsection (a) does not 12 apply if: The snowmobile or ATV is owned by or in the 13 14 possession of a dealer who has been issued a dealer 15 registration certificate, dealer registration plates and 16 dealer plate registration cards under section 7711 (relating 17 to registration of dealers), the dealer is in compliance with section 7711 and the snowmobile or ATV is used in accordance 18

with section 7711.

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- 1 (2) The snowmobile or ATV is owned and used by the
- 2 United States or another state or a political subdivision
- 3 thereof, in which case the snowmobile or ATV shall display
- 4 the name of the owner in a manner prescribed by the
- 5 department.
- 6 (3) The snowmobile or ATV is operated on land owned or
- 7 leased by the owner or operator of the snowmobile or ATV and
- 8 it is not operated elsewhere within this Commonwealth.
- 9 (4) The owner of the snowmobile or ATV is not a resident
- of this Commonwealth and the operator presents proof that the
- snowmobile or ATV has been properly registered in another
- jurisdiction that exempts from its registration requirements
- persons who have obtained proper registration under this
- 14 chapter.
- 15 (5) The snowmobile is a vintage snowmobile.
- 16 (6) The owner of the ATV:
- 17 (i) is not a resident of this Commonwealth and
- 18 resides in another jurisdiction that does not exempt from
- 19 its registration requirements persons who have obtained
- 20 proper registration under this chapter; and
- 21 (ii) acquires a pass under section 7719 (relating to
- 22 <u>nonresident ATV pass).</u>
- 23 § 7715.2. Fees.
- 24 (a) Fees.--Except as provided in subsection (b), the
- 25 department shall collect the following fees:
- 26 (1) Certificate of title, \$22.50.
- 27 (2) Expiration sticker, \$20.
- 28 (2.1) Vintage snowmobile permit, \$20.
- 29 (3) Dealer registration, \$25.
- 30 (4) Replacement, due to loss or damage, of registration

- 1 certificate, limited registration certificate, registration
- decal, registration plate, expiration sticker or vintage
- 3 snowmobile permit, \$5.
- 4 (5) Transfer of registration pursuant to section 7711.1
- 5 (relating to registration of snowmobile or ATV), \$5.
- 6 (6) Recording the name of a secured party on a
- 7 certificate of title, \$5.
- 8 (7) Nonresident ATV pass under section 7719 (relating to
- 9 nonresident ATV pass), \$20.

- 11 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 12 § 7719. Nonresident ATV pass.
- 13 (a) Issuance of pass. -- Upon receipt of an application upon a
- 14 form prescribed and furnished by the department that shall
- 15 contain information required by the department and be
- 16 <u>accompanied</u> by the required fee and any other information the
- 17 <u>department shall require</u>, the department shall issue to an owner
- 18 of an ATV who is not a resident of this Commonwealth and resides
- 19 <u>in another jurisdiction that does not exempt from its</u>
- 20 registration requirements persons who have obtained proper
- 21 registration under this chapter, a nonresident ATV pass for a
- 22 period not to exceed 10 days.
- 23 (b) Carrying and exhibiting pass. -- A pass shall, at all
- 24 times while the ATV is being operated, be in the possession of
- 25 the person driving or in control of the ATV or carried in the
- 26 ATV and shall be exhibited on demand of a police officer or
- 27 <u>authorized department employee.</u>
- 28 (c) Not transferable. -- A nonresident ATV pass is not
- 29 transferable to a successor owner of the ATV or to another ATV.
- 30 (d) Suspension or revocation. -- The department may suspend or

- 1 revoke a nonresident ATV pass upon conviction of the holder of
- 2 an offense under this chapter. A suspended or revoked
- 3 nonresident ATV pass is invalid.
- 4 (e) Online registration. -- The department shall promulgate
- 5 rules and regulations to provide for online registration.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
