AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for 2 the offenses of homicide by vehicle, aggravated assault by 3 vehicle, homicide by vehicle while driving under influence 4 and aggravated assault by vehicle while driving under the 5 influence. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Sections 3732(b), 3732.1(b) and 3735 of Title 75 10 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 11 § 3732. Homicide by vehicle. * * * 12 13 (b) Sentencing. --14 In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a 15 person convicted of a violation of subsection (a) may be 16 sentenced to an additional term not to exceed five years' 17 confinement if at trial the prosecution proves beyond a 18 reasonable doubt that the offense occurred in an active work 19 zone.

(1.1) In addition to any other penalty provided by law,

- 1 a person convicted of a violation of subsection (a) [as the
- 2 result of a violation of section], who is also convicted of a
- 3 violation of section 1501 (relating to drivers required to be
- 4 <u>licensed</u>), 1543 (relating to driving while operating
- 5 <u>privilege is suspended or revoked),</u> 3316 (relating to
- 6 prohibiting text-based communications), 3325 (relating to
- 7 duty of driver on approach of emergency vehicle) or 3327
- 8 (relating to duty of driver in emergency response areas) [and
- 9 who is convicted of violating section 3316, 3325 or 3327],
- may be sentenced to an additional term not to exceed five
- 11 years' confinement [when the violation resulted in death].
- 12 (2) The prosecution must indicate intent to proceed
- under this section in the indictment or information which
- 14 commences the prosecution.
- 15 (3) The Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing, pursuant
- to 42 Pa.C.S. § 2154 (relating to adoption of guidelines for
- 17 sentencing), shall provide for a sentencing enhancement for
- 18 an offense under this section when the violation occurred in
- an active work zone or [was the result of a violation of
- section] the individual was also convicted of a violation of
- 21 <u>section 1501, 1543, 3316, 3325 or 3327.</u>

- 25 (1) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a
- 26 person convicted of a violation of subsection (a) may be
- 27 sentenced to an additional term not to exceed two years'

- sentencing), shall provide for a sentencing enhancement for
- an offense under this section when the violation occurred in
- 21 an active work zone or [was the result of a violation of
- 22 section] the individual was also convicted of a violation of
- 23 section 1501, 1543, 3316, 3325 or 3327.
- 24 § 3735. Homicide by vehicle while driving under influence.
- 25 (a) Offense defined.--
- 26 (1) Any person who unintentionally causes the death of
- another person as the result of a violation of section 3802
- 28 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled
- substance) and who is convicted of violating section 3802 is
- 30 guilty of a felony of the second degree when the violation is

- 1 the cause of death and the sentencing court shall order the
- 2 person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not less
- 3 than three years. [A consecutive three-year term of
- 4 imprisonment shall be imposed for each victim whose death is
- 5 the result of the violation of section 3802.]
- 6 (2) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a
- 7 person convicted of a violation of paragraph (1) and a
- 8 <u>violation of section 1501 (relating to drivers required to be</u>
- 9 <u>licensed</u>) or 1543 (relating to driving while operating
- 10 privilege is suspended or revoked) when committed at the same
- 11 <u>time and place may be sentenced to an additional term under</u>
- 12 <u>subsection (b) (2) not to exceed two years' confinement.</u>
- 13 (3) A consecutive term of imprisonment under this
- 14 <u>subsection shall be imposed for each victim whose death is</u>
- the result of the violation of section 3802.
- 16 (b) Applicability of sentencing guidelines.--[The]
- 17 <u>(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the</u> sentencing guidelines
- 18 promulgated by the Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing
- shall not supersede the mandatory penalty of this section.
- 20 (2) For a penalty under subsection (a) (2), the
- Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing, pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S.
- 22 § 2154 (relating to adoption of guidelines for sentencing),
- 23 shall determine the term of a sentencing enhancement in
- 24 addition to the existing mandatory penalty of this section.
- 25 Section 2. Section 3735.1 of Title 75 is amended by adding a
- 26 subsection to read:
- 27 § 3735.1. Aggravated assault by vehicle while driving under the
- influence.
- 29 * * *
- 30 (a.1) Sentencing. -- In addition to any other penalty provided

- 1 by law, a person convicted of a violation of subsection (a) and
- 2 <u>a violation of section 1501 (relating to drivers required to be</u>
- 3 <u>licensed) or 1543 (relating to driving while operating privilege</u>
- 4 <u>is suspended or revoked</u>) when committed at the same time and
- 5 place may be sentenced to an additional term not to exceed two
- 6 <u>years' confinement.</u>
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
