A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Signature Learning Experiences program of
2 Elizabethtown College.

3 WHEREAS, Elizabethtown College, located in Elizabethtown,
4 Pennsylvania, has become one of the national models for
5 embedding real-world learning experiences into the standard
6 college curriculum; and

7 WHEREAS, Elizabethtown College was one of eight colleges and
8 universities selected by the Association of American Colleges &
9 Universities (AAC&U) in 2015 to participate in an Arthur Vining
10 Davis Foundations funded project to showcase capstones and
11 signature works; and

12 WHEREAS, The projects and results were published in AAC&U's
13 Spring 2018 issue of *Peer Review*; and

14 WHEREAS, For the project, Elizabethtown College established a
15 Signature Learning Experiences program which required the
16 graduating classes of 2017 and 2018 to complete an additional

1 two projects as part of the graduation requirements; and
2 WHEREAS, Projects can include supervised research, cross-
3 cultural experiences or exchanges, internships, field
4 experiences or practicums, community-based learning or a
5 capstone course, project or developmental portfolio; and

6 WHEREAS, The program is incorporated into each year of study
7 from a first-year seminar to a second-year experience for
8 purposeful life work, culminating with a capstone course; and

9 WHEREAS, Other colleges and universities may institute this
10 groundbreaking project to provide not only diverse experiences
11 but also real-world practical knowledge; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
13 Signature Learning Experiences program of Elizabethtown College.
