## A RESOLUTION

- Honoring East Stroudsburg University as it celebrates the 125th anniversary of its founding.
- 3 WHEREAS, In 2018, East Stroudsburg University celebrates the
- 4 125th anniversary of its founding; and
- 5 WHEREAS, East Stroudsburg University traces its roots back to
- 6 1893 with the opening of the East Stroudsburg Normal School, a
- 7 private preparatory school for teachers that welcomed 320
- 8 students; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 1897, 62 women and 12 men became the first
- 10 graduating class of the East Stroudsburg Normal School; and
- 11 WHEREAS, In 1920, the ownership of East Stroudsburg Normal
- 12 School was transferred to the Commonwealth and became East
- 13 Stroudsburg State Normal School with the appointment of a new
- 14 nine-member board of trustees; and
- 15 WHEREAS, In 1926, East Stroudsburg State Normal School became

- 1 a four-year teacher's college, and the following year the school
- 2 was renamed State Teachers College at East Stroudsburg, commonly
- 3 referred to as East Stroudsburg State Teachers College; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In 1960, the college further evolved with the
- 5 addition of more curricula and became a comprehensive State
- 6 college known as East Stroudsburg State College; and
- 7 WHEREAS, In 1962, the college began offering courses leading
- 8 to master of education degrees in biology, general science and
- 9 health and physical education; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Five years later, the college added master's degree
- 11 programs in history, political science and elementary education;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, In 1983, under the authorization of the Pennsylvania
- 14 State System of Higher Education, the college officially became
- 15 East Stroudsburg University; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In 2018, East Stroudsburg University features a
- 17 diverse student body surpassing 6,700 undergraduate and graduate
- 18 students and has expanded to offer 57 undergraduate degree
- 19 programs, 21 master's degree programs and one doctoral degree
- 20 program; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Today, East Stroudsburg University's vision for the
- 22 future includes serving as an innovative and entrepreneurial
- 23 learning center of the 21st century that is committed to its
- 24 local community; and
- 25 WHEREAS, East Stroudsburg University has a rich history and
- 26 cultural heritage spanning the last 125 years that is being
- 27 celebrated by its students, alumni, administration, faculty,
- 28 staff and local community; therefore be it
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor East
- 30 Stroudsburg University as it celebrates the 125th anniversary of

- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives join the
- 3 students, alumni, administration, faculty, staff and local
