AN ACT

Amending Titles 51 (Military Affairs) and 61 (Prisons and Parole) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Department of Military Affairs, further providing for duties of department; in State Veterans' Commission and Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans' Affairs, further providing for 5 specific duties relating to Deputy Adjutant General for 6 Veterans' Affairs; and, in general administration relating to 7 correctional institutions, further providing for powers and duties of department. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 702 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania 13 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 702. Duties of department. 14 The department shall have the power and its duty shall be: 15 * * * 16 17 (13) To contact veterans whose names appear on the list 18 transmitted to the department under 61 Pa.C.S. § 1105(a)(3) 19 (relating to powers and duties of department) and encourage 20 the veterans' voter registration.

- 2 and the section is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 3 § 1712. Specific duties.
- 4 In addition to such other duties as may be provided by law or
- 5 as assigned by the Adjutant General, the Deputy Adjutant General
- 6 for Veterans' Affairs shall have the following specific duties:

- 8 (6) To aid in the rehabilitation of injured, wounded or
- 9 compensable veterans in educational institutions or
- 10 [vocational training] <u>career and technical training</u>
- institutions for which they may be eligible by law.
- 12 (7) To cooperate with and advise the Department of
- 13 Education with respect to [vocational] <u>career and technical</u>
- 14 training programs for veterans, particularly programs suited
- 15 to casualties.

- 17 <u>(17) To encourage voter registration among veterans.</u>
- 18 Section 3. Section 1105(a) of Title 61 is amended by adding
- 19 a paragraph and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
- 20 read:
- 21 § 1105. Powers and duties of department.
- 22 (a) General rule. -- The department shall have the power and
- 23 its duty shall be:
- 24 * * *
- 25 (3) To maintain a list of individuals who are both
- 26 <u>veterans and committed to a term of imprisonment or otherwise</u>
- 27 <u>confined under the custody of the Commonwealth and to</u>
- transmit the individuals' names and addresses, not less than
- 29 <u>30 days prior to the individuals' release or discharge from</u>
- 30 confinement, to the Department of Military and Veterans

- 1 <u>Affairs.</u>
- 2 * * *
- 3 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "veteran"
- 4 means the same as in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7101.2 (relating to
- 5 <u>definitions</u>).
- 6 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
