- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1519 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 1519. Determination of incompetency.

- 10 (d) Vehicle lease termination on incompetency. -- A vehicle
- 11 lessee that entered into a vehicle lease after the effective
- 12 date of this subsection shall not be liable for early
- termination fees or the remainder of vehicle lease payments if 13
- 14 the vehicle lessee's operating privileges have been suspended or
- 15 recalled under this section. The vehicle lessee must return the
- vehicle to the individual or entity that the vehicle was leased 16
- from and provide notice from the department of suspension or 17
- recall of the vehicle lessee's operating privilege. 18

- 1 Section 2. All regulations and parts of regulations are
- 2 abrogated to the extent of any inconsistency with the provisions
- 3 of this act.
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
