15	(1) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (2), any
16	person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the
17	third degree.
18	(2) Any person who negligently or intentionally violates
19	this section commits a misdemeanor of the first degree.

 \$ 2163. Unlawful importation of game or wildlife.

4 (c) Penalties.--

5 (1) Except for endangered or threatened species, a 6 person importing, selling, releasing or possessing game or 7 wildlife or the eggs of any bird contrary to any of the 8 provisions of this section, or causing them to be released or 9 imported, commits a summary offense of the fifth degree. Each 10 bird, egg or animal involved in a violation constitutes a 11 separate offense.

(2) [A] Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (3), a
violation of this section relating to any endangered or
threatened species is a misdemeanor. Each bird, egg or game
or wildlife involved in the violation constitutes a separate
offense.

17 (3) A negligent or intentional violation of this section
 18 relating to any endangered or threatened species is a
