A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of May 2024 as "Nurses Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, There are many types of nurses, including registered
4	nurses, licensed practical nurses and advanced practice nurses,
5	which include certified nurse midwives, certified registered
6	nurse practitioners and certified nurse anesthetists, and many
7	other different types as well; and
8	WHEREAS, Nurses were on the front lines during the COVID-19
9	pandemic, putting their lives at risk to look after others and
10	combat the novel coronavirus as models of bravery for all of us;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, Nurses accounted for one-third of all health care
13	workforce deaths in the first year of the COVID-19 pandemic; and
14	WHEREAS, A strong nursing workforce increases access to
15	health care, reduces health disparities along socioeconomic and

1 racial lines and improves the health and wellness of our 2 communities; and

3 WHEREAS, Many important individuals throughout history who 4 modeled selfless service and broke down barriers were nurses; 5 and

6 WHEREAS, Florence Nightingale was considered the founder of 7 modern nursing, and she established the first scientifically 8 based nursing school in London; and

9 WHEREAS, Harriet Tubman, who led enslaved people to freedom 10 through the underground railroad in Pennsylvania, was a nurse; 11 and

12 WHEREAS, Other notable individuals throughout history who 13 worked in the nursing field include Mother Teresa, Dorothea Dix, 14 Walt Whitman, Hazel Johnson-Brown, Sylvia Mendez and Mary Eliza 15 Mahoney; and

16 WHEREAS, Nurses do not just work in hospitals and doctors' 17 offices but in many workplaces and settings; and

18 WHEREAS, School nurses ensure full health care access for 19 both children experiencing medical emergencies and children with 20 chronic medical conditions; and

21 WHEREAS, It takes years of schooling and passing 22 accreditation exams in order to become a nurse; and

23 WHEREAS, A successful nurse's crucial skills include critical 24 thinking, compassion, professionalism, stress management and 25 resilience; and

26 WHEREAS, Many nurses work long shifts and odd hours that can 27 keep them away from their families and friends; and

28 WHEREAS, Nurses do important, tiring and thankless work all 29 throughout our society; therefore be it
