AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 5796, carrying
2 State Route 4001 over U.S. Route 22 in Allegheny Township,
3 Blair County, as the LCPL Ralph J. Fabbri USMC Memorial
4 Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. LCPL Ralph J. Fabbri USMC Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) Ralph John Fabbri was born September 29, 1989, in
11 Altoona, Blair County.

12 (2) LCPL Fabbri attended Penn Cambria High School and
13 graduated in 2008.

14 (3) During his time at Penn Cambria, LCPL Fabbri was
15 active in arts groups and had some of his work exhibited at
16 Mount Aloysius College.

17 (4) Following a period of military service, LCPL Fabbri
18 intended to become an art teacher.

19 (5) On August 11, 2008, LCPL Fabbri enlisted in the

1 United States Marine Corps.

2 (6) LCPL Fabbri was assigned to the Headquarters
3 Battalion, 1st Marine Division, I Marine Expeditionary Force,
4 Camp Pendleton, California.

5 (7) LCPL Fabbri was deployed to Afghanistan and
6 participated in Operation Enduring Freedom.

7 (8) On September 28, 2010, LCPL Fabbri was killed in
8 action in the Helmand Province of Afghanistan.

9 (9) LCPL Fabbri's death occurred one day before his 21st
10 birthday.

11 (10) LCPL Fabbri was due home from his tour in October
12 2010, and was to meet his high school sweetheart at the
13 Marine Corps Ball in November 2010.

14 (11) Upon his passing, LCPL Fabbri was honored by the
15 Governors of Pennsylvania and California for his ultimate
16 sacrifice to our nation.

17 (12) LCPL Fabbri's remains traveled under the bridge
18 that is the subject of this act when his body was returned to
19 the United States after his death.

20 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key 5796,
21 carrying State Route 4001 over U.S. Route 22 in Allegheny
22 Township, Blair County, is designated as the LCPL Ralph J.
23 Fabbri USMC Memorial Bridge.

24 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
25 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
26 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

27 Section 2. Effective date.

28 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
