## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of November 2023 as "Native American 2 Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The history and culture of our great nation have
- 4 been significantly influenced by Native American and Indigenous

- 6 WHEREAS, The contributions of Native Americans have enhanced
- 7 the freedom, prosperity and greatness of America today; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Their customs and traditions are respected and
- 9 celebrated as part of a rich legacy throughout the United
- 10 States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, "Native American Awareness Week" began in 1976 and
- 12 recognition was expanded by the Congress of the United States
- 13 and approved by the President in August 1990, designating the
- 14 month of November as "National Native American Heritage Month";

- 16 WHEREAS, In honor of "Native American Heritage Month,"
