| 5 | with disabilities, was signed into law on July 26, 1990; and |
| 6 | WHEREAS, Described as the Emancipation Proclamation for the |
| 7 | disability community, the ADA prohibits discrimination on the |
| 8 | basis of any disability; and |
| 9 | WHEREAS, A disability can occur at birth or through accident, |
| 10 | disease or aging; and |
| 11 | WHEREAS, More than 50 million people in the United States, |
| 12 | including more than 1.6 million people in this Commonwealth, |
| 13 | have some level of disability; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, The ADA promotes accessibility, equality of |

opportunity, full participation, independent living and economic self-sufficiency for individuals with disabilities; and WHEREAS, The ADA has opened public institutions; and WHEREAS, The ADA has expanded the benefits and privileges of education and employment; and
