A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Daniel A. Dailey, the 15th Sergeant Major of the  
2 Army, for his notable military career and further recognizing  
3 his current rank and service.

4 WHEREAS, A Palmerton native and 1990 graduate of Palmerton  
5 Area High School, Sergeant Major of the Army (SMA) Dailey  
6 enlisted in the Army in 1989; and

7 WHEREAS, Having earned the rank of command sergeant major in  
8 2004, SMA Dailey demonstrated exceptional discipline and  
9 professionalism as an infantryman, instructor and leader during  
10 five combat deployments; and

11 WHEREAS, SMA Dailey completed multiple tours in Europe and  
12 Asia and participated in Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm,  
13 Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn; and

14 WHEREAS, SMA Dailey's military honors and awards include the  
15 Iraq Campaign Medal with five bronze service stars, the Korea  
16 Defense Service Medal, the Kuwait Liberation Medal (Kuwait), the

1 Kuwait Liberation Medal (Saudi Arabia), the Army Service Ribbon  
2 and numerous other military honors and awards; and

3 WHEREAS, SMA Dailey provided distinguished leadership,  
4 counsel and outreach as command senior major for the United  
5 States Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) at Fort  
6 Eustis, Virginia; and

7 WHEREAS, At TRADOC, SMA Dailey was committed to his duties on  
8 behalf of senior military leaders and his responsibilities to  
9 strengthen the standards and training of Army personnel  
10 consistent with the unique challenges and rigors of military  
11 life and combat service; and

12 WHEREAS, SMA Dailey furthered Army plans for leadership  
13 development and shaped key elements of the soldier 2020  
14 initiative while at Fort Eustis; and

15 WHEREAS, SMA Dailey was installed as Sergeant Major of the  
16 Army at the Pentagon following the January 30, 2015, retirement  
17 of Sergeant Major of the Army Raymond F. Chandler III; and

18 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of  
19 Pennsylvania extends its best wishes for SMA Dailey's tenure as  
20 the most senior enlisted member of the Army and offers its  
21 respect for his authority on matters affecting the enlisted  
22 force; therefore be it
