A RESOLUTION

- Designating October 23, 2015, as "World Polio Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Rotary International, founded on February 23, 1905,
- 4 in Chicago, Illinois, is the world's first and one of the
- 5 largest nonprofit service organizations; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In 1985, Rotary International launched Polioplus and
- 7 spearheaded the Global Polio Eradication Initiative with the
- 8 World Health Organization, the United States Centers for Disease
- 9 Control and Prevention and the United Nations Children's Fund to
- 10 immunize the children of the world against polio; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Polio cases have dropped by 99% since 1988 and the
- 12 world stands on the threshold of eradicating the disease; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Rotary International has contributed more than \$1
- 14 billion and countless volunteer hours for the protection of more

- 1 than 2 billion children in 122 countries; and
- 2 WHEREAS, These efforts are providing much needed operational
- 3 support, medical personnel, laboratory equipment and educational
- 4 materials for health workers and parents; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Rotary International has played a major role in
- 6 decisions by donor governments to contribute \$8 billion to the
- 7 effort; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The 12,147 Pennsylvanian Rotarians in 369 Rotary
- 9 clubs throughout this Commonwealth continue to sponsor service
- 10 projects to address such critical issues as poverty, health,
- 11 hunger, illiteracy and the environment in their local
- 12 communities and abroad; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate October
- 14 23, 2015, as "World Polio Day" in Pennsylvania and encourage all
- 15 residents to join in the fight for a polio-free world.
