AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for
3 contributions for pediatric cancer research and establishing
4 the Pediatric Cancer Research Fund.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1321. Contributions for pediatric cancer research.

10 (a) General rule.--Within one year of the effective date of
11 this section, the department shall provide for all of the
12 following:

13 (1) Ability of an applicant for an original or renewal
14 driver's license or identification card to make a
15 contribution of \$5 to the Pediatric Cancer Research Fund.

16 (2) Ability of an applicant for a renewal vehicle
17 registration to make a contribution of \$5 to the Pediatric
18 Cancer Research Fund.

1 (b) Implementation.--

2 (1) A contribution under subsection (a) shall be added,
3 as appropriate, to the regular fee for:

4 (i) an original or renewal driver's license or
5 identification card; and

6 (ii) a renewal of a vehicle registration.

7 (2) One contribution under subsection (a) may be made
8 for:

9 (i) each issuance or renewal of a driver's license
10 or identification card; and

11 (ii) each renewal vehicle registration.

12 (c) Use.--Contributions under subsection (a) shall be used
13 exclusively for pediatric cancer research approved by the
14 Pennsylvania Cancer Control, Prevention and Research Advisory
15 Board established by the act December 18, 1980 (P.L.1241, No.
16 224), known as the Pennsylvania Cancer Control, Prevention and
17 Research Act.

18 (d) Deposits.--

19 (1) The department shall determine on a monthly basis
20 the total amount collected under this section and report the
21 amount to the State Treasurer.

22 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer the amount
23 collected to the Pediatric Cancer Research Fund, which fund
24 is hereby established.

25 (e) Reimbursement.--The Pediatric Cancer Research Fund shall
26 reimburse the Motor License Fund for the actual costs incurred
27 by the department in the administration of this section.

28 (f) Information.--

29 (1) The department shall provide adequate information
30 concerning the contribution for pediatric cancer research in

1 its instructions for the applicants described in subsection
2 (a). The information concerning the contribution shall
3 include the listing of an address furnished by the Department
4 of Health to which contributions may be sent by individuals
5 wishing to make additional contributions.

6 (2) The Department of Health shall conduct a public
7 information campaign on the availability of this opportunity
8 to Pennsylvania taxpayers.

9 (g) Reporting.--The Department of Health shall report
10 annually to the respective committees of the Senate and the
11 House of Representatives that have jurisdiction over health
12 matters on the amount received from the contributions authorized
13 by this section and how the funds were used.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
