10 (d) Natural gas vehicles.--

hereby enacts as follows:

- 11 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
- 12 <u>vehicle that is operated by an engine fueled primarily by</u>
- compressed or liquefied natural gas may exceed the gross
- 14 vehicle weight limits and any axle weight limits imposed
- 15 <u>under this subchapter by an amount, not to exceed a maximum</u>
- of 2,000 pounds, that is equal to the difference between the
- 17 <u>weight of the vehicle attributable to the natural gas tank</u>
- and fueling system carried by the vehicle and the weight of a

- 1 <u>comparable diesel tank and fueling system.</u>
- 2 (2) The weight exemption provided for under this
- 3 <u>subsection shall apply to all State highways and interstate</u>
- 4 <u>highways as provided by the exemption permitted under 23</u>
- 5 <u>U.S.C.</u> § 127 (relating to vehicle weight limitations -
- 6 <u>Interstate System</u>).
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
