1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in other required equipment, further providing for visual signals on authorized vehicles.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 4572 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 4572. Visual signals on authorized vehicles.

10	(d) Emergency towing lights The following shall apply:
11	(1) A tow truck may be equipped with one or more
12	flashing or revolving yellow lights and one or more flashing
13	or revolving red lights to remove a disabled vehicle under
14	one of the following conditions:
15	(i) Responding to a 911 dispatch.
16	(ii) Responding to a request from law enforcement
17	for the removal of a disabled vehicle.
18	(iii) Responding to a request from the owner or

1	operator of the disabled vehicle.
2	(2) The manner in which the light or lights shall be
3	displayed and the intensity shall be determined by regulation
4	of the department.
5	(3) The combination of yellow and red lights specified
6	in this subsection may be used only during the period in
7	which the tow truck is at the incident to which it was
8	dispatched or requested for the removal of a disabled
9	vehicle. Use of the combination lights to and from the
10	incident is prohibited.
1	(4) Unauthorized use of the lights specified in this
_2	subsection shall be a summary offense punishable by a fine of
13	not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.
4	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
