AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in fees, further providing for annual hauling  
3 permits; and, in size, weight and load, further providing for  
4 permit for movement during course of manufacture.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 1943(c)(2) and 4968(a.2)(5) of Title 75  
8 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:  
9 § 1943. Annual hauling permits.

11 (c) Course of manufacture.--The annual fee for operation or  
12 movement of loads or vehicles, as provided for in section 4968  
13 (relating to permit for movement during course of manufacture),  
14 shall be as follows:

16 (2) Overweight movements:

17 (i) Movements not exceeding 100,000 pounds gross  
18 weight:

19 (A) Not more than one mile in distance - \$69.

1 (B) More than one mile in distance up to 50  
2 miles - \$750.

3 (C) More than 50 miles in distance - \$900.

4 (ii) Movements in excess of 100,000 pounds gross  
5 weight - \$756, plus \$152 for each mile of highway  
6 authorized under the permit.

8 § 4968. Permit for movement during course of manufacture.

10 (a.2) Specifications.--

11 \* \* \*

12 (5) A combination of vehicles which is hauling [a hot  
13 ingot] hot ingots or a hot box may be permitted by the  
14 department and local authorities to move upon highways within  
15 their respective jurisdictions a distance not exceeding [25]  
16 125 miles if the gross weight does not exceed 150,000 pounds  
17 and the weight of any nonsteering axle does not exceed 21,000  
18 pounds. No permit may be issued for this type of movement  
19 upon an interstate highway.

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
