- 12 sciences living and working in this Commonwealth, providing the
- 13 highest diagnostic and therapeutic care to individuals; and
- 14 WHEREAS, These medical professionals are dedicated to the
- 15 highest standard of professionalism and continually maintain
- 16 those standards through education, lifelong learning,
- 17 credentialing and personal commitment; therefore be it
