## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Titles 53 (Municipalities Generally) and 75 (Vehicles)
- of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in employees,
- providing for the Municipal Police Recruitment and Retention
- 4 Program and establishing the Municipal Police Recruitment and
- 5 Retention Program Fund; and, in penalties and disposition of
- fines, providing for law enforcement enhancement surcharge.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 10 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 11 § 2172. Municipal Police Recruitment and Retention Program.
- 12 (a) Establishment.--There is established in the State
- 13 Treasury the Municipal Police Recruitment and Retention Program
- 14 Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund. Money in the fund shall be
- 15 expended for the purposes set forth in this section.
- 16 (b) Administration. -- The commission shall administer the
- 17 <u>fund and make grants from the fund for recruitment and retention</u>
- 18 of a municipality's part-time police force in accordance with
- 19 this section.
- 20 (c) Purpose of grants.--Grants shall be for the purpose of

- 1 <u>hiring and retaining part-time police officers in a municipality</u>
- 2 and shall be used to pay a portion of the salary of a part-time
- 3 police officer. Grants shall not exceed \$5,000 per police
- 4 <u>officer position and shall be used to supplement the part-time</u>
- 5 police officer's salary paid by the municipality up to a maximum
- 6 of \$15 per hour of pay, not to exceed 85% of a full-time base
- 7 <u>salary for a police officer in the municipality. The rate shall</u>
- 8 <u>be calculated based on average salaries for 2017 as adjusted</u>
- 9 <u>annually by the Consumer Price Index for the metropolitan area</u>
- 10 in which the municipality is located.
- 11 (d) Other funds.--In addition to the money available in the
- 12 fund, an appropriation for municipal police officer training
- 13 that remains as part of the commission prior to lapsing shall be
- 14 deposited in the fund beginning with the current fiscal year,
- 15 for the purposes contained in this section.
- 16 (e) Regulations. -- The commission shall promulgate rules and
- 17 regulations to implement and administer the provisions of this
- 18 section within 90 days of the effective date of this section.
- (f) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 20 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 21 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 22 "Fund." The Municipal Police Recruitment and Retention
- 23 Program Fund established under subsection (a).
- 24 "Municipality." A city of the third class, borough, township
- 25 of the first class or township of the second class that provides
- 26 local police services through a municipal police department,
- 27 participation in a regional police department or contracts with
- 28 other municipal or regional police.
- 29 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 30 § 6508. Law enforcement enhancement surcharge.

- 1 (a) Levy and imposition. -- In addition to any fines, fees or
- 2 penalties levied or imposed as provided by law under this title
- 3 or any other statute, a surcharge shall be levied for
- 4 <u>disposition in accordance with subsection (b). Upon conviction</u>
- 5 for a violation of the provisions of this title or other statute
- 6 of this Commonwealth, or regulations promulgated under this
- 7 title, which is a traffic violation, exclusive of parking
- 8 offenses, a surcharge of \$10 shall be levied.
- 9 (b) Disposition. -- Notwithstanding the provisions of 42
- 10 Pa.C.S. §§ 3571 (relating to Commonwealth portion of fines,
- 11 etc.) and 3573 (relating to municipal corporation portion of
- 12 fines, etc.), all surcharges levied and collected under
- 13 <u>subsection</u> (a) by a division of the unified judicial system
- 14 existing under section 1 of Article V of the Constitution of
- 15 Pennsylvania and 42 Pa.C.S. § 301 (relating to unified judicial
- 16 system) shall be remitted to the Commonwealth for deposit in the
- 17 Municipal Police Recruitment and Retention Program Fund,
- 18 established under 53 Pa.C.S. § 2172 (relating to Municipal
- 19 Police Recruitment and Retention Program), for the purpose of
- 20 recruiting and retaining municipal police officers.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
