Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers of department and local authorities, 2 further providing for specific powers of department and local 3 authorities. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 6109 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 6109. Specific powers of department and local authorities. 9 * * * 10 11 (i) Delegation of powers in cities of the second class A and 12 third class.--(1) Notwithstanding a provision of 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 55 or 13 this title to the contrary, beginning January 1, 2018, the 14 15 parking authority of a city of the second class A or city of 16 the third class may enforce and administer ordinances and resolutions enacted or adopted by the city of the second 17 class A or city of the third class under the powers specified 18 under subsection (a) (1) and those certain stopping, standing 19

| 3 | (2) Beginning March 1, 2018, the parking authority of a |

| 19 | and parking provisions provided in sections 3351, 3353 and |

| 21 | (i) The installation and maintenance of all |
| 22 | equipment, including parking meters, on and along |
| 23 | highways, streets and roadways. |
| 24 | (ii) The installation and maintenance of all |
| 25 | signage, including signage for handicapped parking, |
| 26 | residential permit parking and loading areas, on and |
| 27 | along highways, streets and roadways. |
| 28 | (iii) The operation and management of any |
| 29 | handicapped parking, residential parking and loading area |
| 30 | permit programs. |

| 1 | <u>(iv) The adjudication of all disputed parking</u> |
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| 2 | violation notices or citations issued through enforcement |
| 3 | by the parking authority in a city of the second class A |
| 4 | or city of the third class. |
| 5 | "Enforce." The issuance of parking violation notices or |
| 6 | citations, the immobilization, towing and impoundment of |
| 7 | motor vehicles and the collection of fines, penalties and |
| 8 | costs, including independent collection agency fees, for |
| 9 | violations of any ordinance or resolution enacted in order to |
| 10 | regulate or prohibit the stopping, standing or parking of |
| 11 | motor vehicles in a city of the second class A and city of |
| 12 | the third class and those certain stopping, standing and |
| 13 | parking provisions provided in sections 3351, 3353 and 3354. |
| 14 | Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. |
