## AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937) P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of unemployment compensation to be administered by the 3 Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly 4 created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions) 5 selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to 6 keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay 7 contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons; 8 9 providing procedure and administrative details for the 10 determination, payment and collection of such contributions 11 and the payment of such compensation; providing for 12 cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies; 13 creating certain special funds in the custody of the State 14 Treasurer; and prescribing penalties," in administration of 15 act, providing for emergency unemployment compensation 16 17 assistance. 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 19 hereby enacts as follows: 20 Section 1. The act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 21 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, is 22 amended by adding a section to read: 23 Section 215. Emergency Unemployment Compensation 24 Assistance. -- (a) The Governor shall hire additional employes or reassign employes from other Commonwealth departments, boards or 25
- 26 commissions, including full-time and part-time furloughed

- 1 employes, in accordance with sections 501 and 502 of the act of
- 2 April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative"
- 3 Code of 1929," for the Office of Unemployment Compensation and
- 4 <u>unemployment compensation service centers to ensure that</u>
- 5 <u>eliqible claimants are able to receive the benefits provided</u>
- 6 under this act. The Department of Labor and Industry shall hire
- 7 <u>additional employes or reassign Commonwealth employes under this</u>
- 8 subsection commensurate with need, if:
- 9 <u>(1) The Commonwealth enters an extended benefit period as</u>
- 10 <u>defined by section 401-A.</u>
- 11 (2) A state of disaster emergency is declared or a
- 12 <u>declaration is renewed under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to</u>
- 13 general authority of Governor).
- 14 (b) In determining whether the Department of Labor and
- 15 <u>Industry needs to hire additional employes or reassign</u>
- 16 Commonwealth employes, the Governor, in conjunction with the
- 17 <u>Secretary of Labor and Industry, shall consult with all of the</u>
- 18 <u>following:</u>
- 19 (1) The chair and minority chair of the Labor and Industry
- 20 Committee of the Senate.
- 21 (2) The chair and minority chair of the Labor and Industry
- 22 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 23 (c) The Department of Labor and Industry shall hire
- 24 additional employes or reassign Commonwealth employes under
- 25 <u>subsection</u> (a) in a manner that preserves the health and safety
- 26 of the employes at the Office of Unemployment Compensation and
- 27 <u>unemployment compensation service centers.</u>
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
