10	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Exclusion of	
11	Veterans' Disability Benefits as Income Act.	
12	Section 2. Eligibility income.	
13	Veterans' disability benefits shall not be deemed income for-	
14	purposes of eligibility under any of the following:	
15	(1) The definition of "income" in section 502 of the act	_
16	of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State	
17	Lottery Law.	
18	(2) Chapter 13 of the act of June 27, 2006 (1st-	

1	Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act.
2	(3) 75 Pa.C.S. § 1901(c)(16) (relating to exemption of
3	persons, entities and vehicles from fees).
4	Section 3. Applicability.
5	This act shall apply as follows:
6	(1) Section 2(1) and (2) shall apply to income received
7	in calendar year 2022 and each calendar year thereafter.
8	(2) Section 2(3) shall apply to registration fees issued
9	or renewed on or after July 1, 2023.
10	Section 4. Effective date.
11	This act shall take effect immediately.

20	THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS CHAPTER
21	SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE
22	CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
23	"COMMONWEALTH PROGRAM." A PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE
24	COMMONWEALTH THAT REQUIRES, AS A CONDITION FOR ELIGIBILITY, THE
25	INCLUSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S INCOME.
26	"VETERAN." AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES
27	ARMED FORCES, INCLUDING A RESERVE COMPONENT OR NATIONAL GUARD,
28	AND WHO WAS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED FROM THAT SERVICE UNDER
29	CONDITIONS OTHER THAN DISHONORABLE.
30	"VETERANS' BENEFIT PAYMENT." COMPENSATION OR PAYMENT

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1	RECEIVED BY A VETERAN THAT IS DIRECTLY RELATED TO OR THE RESULT
2	OF THE VETERAN'S SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY AS DETERMINED BY
3	THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OR BENEFITS
4	PROVIDED TO A VETERAN BY A COMMONWEALTH AGENCY OR AUTHORIZED
5	UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH.
6	§ 9902. EXCLUSION.
7	(A) GENERAL RULE ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF A VETERANS'
8	BENEFIT PAYMENT MAY NOT BE INCLUDED AS INCOME FOR ANY
9	COMMONWEALTH PROGRAM.
10	(B) EXTENSION TO SPOUSES THE EXCLUSION UNDER THIS SECTION
11	SHALL APPLY TO AN UNMARRIED SURVIVING SPOUSE UPON THE DEATH OF A
12	VETERAN FOR ANY COMPENSATION OR PAYMENT THE UNMARRIED SURVIVING
13	SPOUSE IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE.

14 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
