## AN ACT

Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the exclusion of 2 veterans' benefit payments from income for Commonwealth 3 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Definitions. 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 17 context clearly indicates otherwise: "Commonwealth program." A program administered by the 18

Commonwealth that requires, as a condition for eligibility, the

- 1 inclusion of an individual's income.
- 2 "Veteran." An individual who served in the United States
- 3 Armed Forces, including a reserve component or National Guard,
- 4 and who was discharged or released from that service under\_
- 5 conditions other than dishonorable.
- 6 <u>"Veterans' benefit payment." Compensation or payment</u>
- 7 received by a veteran that is directly related to or the result
- 8 of the veteran's service-connected disability as determined by
- 9 <u>the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or benefits</u>
- 10 provided to a veteran by a Commonwealth agency or authorized
- 11 under the laws of this Commonwealth.
- 12 § 9902. Exclusion.
- 13 (a) Income exclusion. -- One hundred percent of a veterans'
- 14 benefit payment may not be included as income for any
- 15 <u>Commonwealth program.</u>
- 16 (b) Extension to spouses. -- The exclusion under subsection
- 17 (a) shall apply to an unmarried surviving spouse upon the death
- 18 of a veteran for any compensation or payment the unmarried
- 19 surviving spouse is entitled to receive.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
