## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," establishing the Digital Protection 5 School Safety Account; and providing for duties of school 6 entities and the department. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an 11 12 article to read: 13 ARTICLE XIII-E 14 DIGITAL PROTECTION SCHOOL SAFETY ACCOUNT Section 1301-E. Definitions. 15 16 The following words and phrases when used in this article 17 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 18 context clearly indicates otherwise: "Account." The Digital Protection School Safety Restricted 19 20 Revenue Account established under section 1302-E. 21 "Department." The Department of Education of the

- 1 Commonwealth.
- 2 <u>"School entity." A school district, intermediate unit, area</u>
- 3 vocational-technical school, charter school, cyber charter
- 4 school or regional charter school.
- 5 Section 1302-E. Establishment of account.
- 6 (a) Establishment. -- The Digital Protection School Safety
- 7 Restricted Revenue Account is established as a restricted
- 8 revenue account within the General Fund. The following shall be
- 9 <u>deposited into the account:</u>
- 10 (1) Money collected by the Department of Revenue and
- 11 <u>designated for school safety initiatives.</u>
- 12 (2) Money allocated to the account by the General
- 13 <u>Assembly.</u>
- 14 (3) Voluntary contributions to the account.
- 15 (4) Interest generated from the money in the account.
- 16 (b) Appropriations. -- Money in the account is appropriated to
- 17 the department on a continuing basis for distribution to school
- 18 entities for the purposes specified under section 1303-E.
- 19 (c) Administration.--
- (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the
- 21 department may coordinate with a State agency or
- 22 nongovernmental organization as necessary to distribute the
- 23 money in the account for the purposes specified under section
- 24 <u>1303-E</u>.
- 25 (2) The department may not enter into an agreement or
- 26 contract with a State agency or nongovernmental organization
- for staffing functions regarding the distribution of money in
- the account for the purposes specified under section 1303-E.
- 29 Section 1303-E. Duties of school entities.
- 30 A school entity shall use the money received under section

- 1 1302-E(b) to implement school safety and violence prevention
- 2 measures through the use of security-related equipment and
- 3 training, including any of the following:
- 4 (1) Student, staff and visitor identification systems.
- 5 (2) Metal detectors.
- 6 (3) Protective lighting.
- 7 <u>(4) Surveillance equipment.</u>
- 8 <u>(5) Special emergency communications equipment.</u>
- 9 (6) Electronic locksets.
- 10 (7) Deadbolts and theft control devices.
- 11 (8) Training in the use of the security-related
- 12 <u>technology</u>.
- 13 (9) Other one-time school safety and violence prevention
- 14 <u>measures approved by the department.</u>
- 15 <u>Section 1304-E. Duties of department.</u>
- 16 (a) Submission.--By July 30, 2020, and each July 30
- 17 thereafter, the department shall submit an annual report on the
- 18 status of the account to all of the following:
- 19 (1) The chair and minority chair of the Appropriations
- 20 <u>Committee of the Senate.</u>
- 21 (2) The chair and minority chair of the Education
- 22 <u>Committee of the Senate.</u>
- 23 (3) The chair and minority chair of the Appropriations
- 24 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 25 (4) The chair and minority chair of the Education
- 26 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 27 <u>(b) Contents.--The report under subsection (a) shall include</u>
- 28 information on all of the following:
- 29 <u>(1) The total amount of money distributed from the</u>
- 30 <u>account in the prior year to each school entity.</u>

- 1 (2) The use of the money distributed from the account
- 2 and the cost for each school safety and violence prevention
- 3 <u>measure.</u>
- 4 (3) The participation by a State agency or
- 5 <u>nongovernmental organization as authorized under section</u>
- 6 1302-E(c).
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
