11	(a) Prohibition No person may enter into, revise or amend
12	any agreement, contract, settlement or similar instrument that
13	includes a provision that:
14	(1) prohibits or attempts to prohibit the disclosure of
15	the name of a person suspected of childhood sexual abuse to
16	<pre>law enforcement authorities;</pre>
17	(2) suppresses or attempts to suppress information
18	relevant to an investigation by law enforcement authorities
19	into a claim of childhood sexual abuse; or

- 2 person to report a claim of childhood sexual abuse to law
- 3 enforcement authorities.
- 4 (b) Void provisions. -- A provision of any agreement,
- 5 contract, settlement or similar instrument that is contrary to
- 6 this section shall be void and unenforceable.
- 7 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 8 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 9 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- "Childhood sexual abuse." Conduct that is subject to 23
- 11 Pa.C.S. Ch. 63 (relating to child protective services) and is
- 12 directed toward or against a child or student, regardless of the
- 13 <u>age of the child or student.</u>
- 14 "Law enforcement authorities." An individual or entity
- 15 charged with the enforcement of Federal, State or local laws.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
