## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in limitation of time,
- providing for declaration of judicial emergencies.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 5506. Declaration of judicial emergencies.
- 9 (a) Judicial emergencies. -- Notwithstanding any other
- 10 provision of this chapter, if the time within which an action
- 11 <u>must be commenced under this chapter is set to expire during a</u>
- 12 judicial emergency declared by a governing authority under
- 13 Article V of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, a law of this
- 14 Commonwealth, a rule of court or other judicial order, the
- 15 <u>following shall apply:</u>
- 16 (1) The time within which the action must be commenced
- 17 <u>shall be tolled.</u>
- 18 (2) A person may commence the action within 30 days

- 1 <u>after the expiration of the declared judicial emergency and</u>
- 2 the action shall be deemed timely filed under section 5503(a)
- 3 (relating to commencement of matters).
- 4 <u>(b) Applicability.--</u>
- 5 (1) This section shall apply to any judicial district
- for which a judicial emergency is declared. If a Statewide
- 7 judicial emergency is declared by a governing authority, this
- 8 <u>section shall apply to all judicial districts.</u>
- 9 (2) This section shall be retroactive to March 18, 2020.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
