5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 9720.9. Global positioning system device to be worn by
10	certain offenders.
11	(a) Condition of probation or parole
12	(1) A person who is placed on probation or released on
13	parole after a conviction for stalking as defined in 18
14	Pa.C.S. § 2709.1 (relating to stalking) may be required as a
15	condition of probation or parole to wear a global positioning
16	system device or comparable device.
17	(2) The order for probation or parole shall establish
18	defined geographic exclusion zones in order to minimize the

- 2 victims.
- 3 (3) If the offender enters an excluded zone, the
- 4 <u>offender's location data shall be immediately transmitted by</u>
- 5 the device to the police department in the municipality where
- 6 the violation occurred and to the probation or parole
- 7 officer, by telephone, electronic beeper, paging device or
- 8 <u>other appropriate means.</u>
- 9 (b) Fees.--The fees incurred for the installation,
- 10 maintenance and operation of the global positioning system
- 11 <u>device or comparable device shall be paid by the offender.</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
