Sentencing procedure for murder of the first degree. * * * 10 11 Instructions to jury. --12 Before the jury retires to consider the sentencing 13 verdict, the court shall instruct the jury on the following 14 matters: * * * 15 16 The verdict must be a sentence of death if the 17 jury unanimously finds at least one aggravating 18 circumstance specified in subsection (d) and no 19 mitigating circumstance or if the jury unanimously finds

- one or more aggravating circumstances which outweigh any
- 2 mitigating circumstances <u>beyond a reasonable doubt</u>. The
- 3 verdict must be a sentence of life imprisonment in all
