## AN ACT

5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 5701 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

- 9 § 5701. Right to bail.
- 10 <u>(a) General rule.--</u>All prisoners shall be bailable by
- 11 sufficient sureties and may not be imprisoned prior to trial for
- 12 <u>inability to satisfy a monetary condition for release</u>, whether
- 13 in the form of cash or secured bond, unless:
- 14 (1) for capital offenses or for offenses for which the 15 maximum sentence is life imprisonment; or
- 16 (2) no condition or combination of conditions other than
  17 imprisonment will reasonably reduce the risk of flight and
  18 assure the safety of any person and the community when the
  19 proof is evident or presumption great.

- 1 (b) Consideration of risk and safety.--
- 2 (1) In assessing the risk of flight under subsection (a)
- 3 (2), only prior instances of not appearing for court dates by
- 4 <u>the prisoner may be considered.</u>
- 5 (2) In assessing safety of any person and the community
- 6 <u>under subsection (a) (2) only behavior of the prisoner related</u>
- 7 <u>to the current offense and a conviction of a prior offense</u>
- 8 <u>may be considered.</u>
- 9 Section 2. The sum of \$500,000 is hereby appropriated to the
- 10 Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency for the purpose
- 11 of providing grants to counties to establish and administer
- 12 pilot programs for transmitting to defendants electronic text
- 13 message reminders relating to appearances at upcoming court
- 14 dates.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
